- RE: Nursing Home and ICF/IID Services Financial Eligibility Timeliness

Due to the World Health Organization declaring Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) a pandemic, the West Virginia Bureau for Medical Services (BMS) is allowing for the following flexibilities in eligibility and enrollment procedures. These measures go into effect immediately and will remain in place through May 31, 2020.

WV nursing facilities and ICF/IIDs have been instructed to limit or restrict visitation to their facilities. Individuals in these facilities may be unable to receive or respond to notices or provide information needed to complete the Medicaid application or redetermination processes.

Working closely with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), BMS will continue to monitor the impact of the pandemic and notify providers and members of additional precautions or extensions.
